Addendum. Interim COVID-19 vaccination coverage in the EU/EEA during the 2023–24 season campaigns — Italy and Sweden




Figure 1. COVID-19 vaccine coverage among people aged 60 years and above, 26 EU/EEA countries, 1 September 2023 to 15 January 2024
