What is the EU Health Task Force (EUHTF)

The EUHTF is a dedicated public health taskforce coordinated by **ECDC**

- · Working upon specific request
- Providing in-country or remote support
- Collaborating with EU/EEA Member States, EC and global health security partners
- Provide operational and crisis preparedness support
- · Covering communicable diseases and diseases of unknown origin

Inputs on or review of MS preparedness and response plans or guidance e.g. following PHEPA assessments

- Testing of preparedness and response plans such as simulation exercises
- In-Action Reviews (IAR), After-Action Reviews (AAR)
- Other requested activities

• Threat detection and monitoring, including following disasters or during mass gathering events

- Risk assessment
- Outbreak investigation and response, including rare or emerging pathogens
- Operational research or investigation during outbreaks, such as of cross-border outbreaks
