Ex-ante publicity notice in negotiated procurement procedure

Subject: "Evaluation of two Disease Programmes: Influenza and other Respiratory Viruses

Programme (IRV) and Food and Waterborne Diseases and zoonoses (FWD)" -

Short description

The purpose of the assignment is to conduct the evaluation of two disease programmes of ECDC:

- Food- and waterborne diseases and zoonoses Programme https://ecdc.europa.eu/en/about-us/who-we-are/disease-programmes/food-and-waterborne-diseases-and-zoonoses-programme
- Influenza and other Respiratory Viruses Programme https://ecdc.europa.eu/en/about-us/who-we-are/disease-programmes/influenza-and-other-respiratory-viruses-programme

This will be an interim evaluation of the programmes in order to assess how the programmes have been addressing current MS (Member States) needs, and fulfilling their objectives, and also to identify key areas for improvement to increase their added value, alignment with similar initiatives from the Commission and other international organisations working in the field, etc.

The evaluations will be based on a common assessment protocol, which includes key evaluation questions, indicators and data sources.

Description of the procedure:

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of a negotiated procurement procedure below 135,000 euros with a minimum of 5 candidates, through which ECDC may award the above-mentioned contract.

All economic operators interested in providing the services described above should express their interest **before 7/11/2017, 16h00 CET,** by e-mail to <u>tenders@ecdc.europa.eu</u> with the same subject reference as indicated above.

In their expression of interest interested economic operators should demonstrate their ability to provide the relevant services and provide the following information:

This information will be taken into account by ECDC in order to identify potential candidates.
