

ECDC Accession Support Action: Work plan 2026

ECDC Accession support to the EU candidate countries and potential candidates: strengthening communicable disease capacities to implement EU *acquis* in surveillance, public health emergency preparedness, and One Health responses against AMR, 2026–2029

Background and description

ECDC's collaboration with non-EU countries is laid down in the [Regulation \(EU\) 2022/2370 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 November 2022 amending Regulation \(EC\) No 853/2004 establishing a European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control the Centre](#) in several articles:

- Article 3: Mission and tasks of the Centre
- Article 5(b): prevention, preparedness and response planning
- Article 9: scientific and technical assistance and training
- Article 11: collection and analysis of data
- Article 11(a): support for international and field preparedness and response
- Article 30: participation of third countries, which have concluded agreements with the EU, to ECDC work and activities

The [signed Memoranda of Understanding](#) set the framework of cooperation between ECDC and national public health authorities in EU candidate countries, and this includes joint implementation of ECDC technical cooperation actions with external funding by the European Commission.

Building on the results achieved to date by five previous projects with IPA beneficiaries¹, on 5 January 2026 the European Union Contribution Agreement No 700004344 was signed between ECDC and the

European Commission (Directorate-General for Enlargement and Eastern Neighbourhood, DG ENEST) to implement [ECDC Accession Support Action](#) with external financial assistance under the EU Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA) and the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument – Global Europe (NDICI).

Project scope

The aim of the project is to prepare the national public health authorities of EU candidate countries and potential candidates for their future participation with ECDC through strengthening their capacities to implement the *EU acquis* on serious cross-border threats to health from infectious diseases and advancing One Health responses against antimicrobial resistance (AMR).

Indicator-based and event-based disease surveillance

In 2026, following the nomination of Observer roles for data reporting to EpiPulse Cases, online training will be provided for experts in Moldova and Ukraine. Training on Legionnaires' disease surveillance reporting to ECDC will be provided, if needed.

All beneficiary countries will be invited to the annual collection of surveillance data on agreed diseases in EpiPulse Cases, participation in EpiPulse Events will be encouraged and ad hoc support provided if necessary. Regular feedback on surveillance data quality, e.g. timeliness or completeness of data reported to ECDC will be provided.

ECDC will design annual surveillance reports for partners under the EU enlargement policy.

Preparedness and response, risk assessment, outbreak investigation, incident management and emergency operation centres

ECDC will design and invite all Action beneficiaries to report their capacities and capabilities related to Chapters II and IV of Regulation 2022/2371, so that the progress on improvement can be measured annually.

Jointly with the countries ECDC will prepare for the upcoming 'observership facility' for ECDC Article 8 missions in EU/EEA countries that is planned as of 2027.

Work stream 2. Advancing One Health approaches against AMR with the technical support from the EC and EFSA

This Action will continue to support Action beneficiary countries in the advancement of the 'One Health' approach against AMR through: (i) the identification of gaps in current national AMR strategies and action plans; (ii) the development of country roadmaps on AMR and support for awareness-raising initiatives; (iii) support in the development of electronic surveillance of AMR. The gap analysis and ECDC/EFSA/EC country visit on One Health against AMR is planned to take place in Albania in 2026, and in Moldova in 2027.

After the country visit report with gap analysis and conclusions is finalised, the development of a roadmap is initiated with the national counterparts to address recommendations and ensure EU standards are respected. In liaison with the national public health and veterinary authorities, it is anticipated that the support to country roadmaps to advance One Health responses on AMR will be provided to the visited countries, i.e. Montenegro, North Macedonia, Serbia, and initiated in Albania.
