Ex-ante publicity notice in negotiated procurement procedure

Subject: Final development and promulgation plan for ECDC Health Emergency Preparedness Country Self Assessment Tool (HEPSA) NP/2016/PHC/5707/01

Short description

ECDC has under development a self-assessment tool for discretionary use by Member States to support the self-assessment of the preparedness of their health emergency response systems and capabilities. The use of the tool is intended to be discretionary and also compatible with reporting requirements under the International Health Regulations (2005) and EU Decision 1082/2013.

The purpose of this assignment is to revise, consult on, and develop the tool as a functional prototype for experiential use and evaluation by country health emergency system leaders and practitioners.

Description of the procedure:

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of a negotiated procurement procedure below 60,000 EUR with a minimum of 3 candidates, through which ECDC may award the above-mentioned contract.

All economic operators interested in providing the services described above should express their interest before **07/07/2016**, 16h00 CET, by e-mail to **tenders@ecdc.europa.eu** with the same subject reference as indicated above.

In their expression of interest interested economic operators should demonstrate their ability to provide the relevant services and provide the following information:
