Dr Bruno Ciancio is a medical epidemiologist and infectious disease specialist. After working as clinical researcher in a university hospital and as epidemiologist in the Italian National Public Health Institute he obtained the EPIET diploma in the UK. He joined the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) in 2006 where he focussed on implementing EU strategies for increasing influenza vaccination coverage, including defining the scientific basis for vaccination, the setting up of the I-MOVE network for monitoring vaccine effectiveness, and the strengthening of surveillance. Between 2011 and 2020 he focussed on establishing the mathematical modelling, GIS, and biostatistical functions of the Centre, supporting the issuing of more impactful scientific outputs, and coordinated the development of the Atlas of Infectious Diseases and of EpiPulse. Between 2020 and 2025 he coordinated ECDC surveillance activities, including the implementation of strategies for harnessing new technologies, such as eHealth, molecular typing, artificial intelligence, and the implementation of the new ECDC mandate. During the COVID-19 pandemic he worked as incident manager and coordinator of the COVID-19 team. Since June 2025 he leads the ECDC Unit for Directly transmitted and Vaccine-preventable Diseases (DVD). Dr Ciancio has authored more than fifty scientific articles in peer-reviewed journals and a book chapter on influenza surveillance.
