In addition, guided and facilitated by my role as department chair, my research interests and efforts have expanded to broader fields in microbiology, including AMR. Finally, since my return from Vietnam, I've been intimately involved in the conception and further development of international initiatives and networks aimed at improved preparedness for- and collaboration in clinical research in the face of emerging epidemics, such as ISARIC (www.isaric.org), Glopid-R (www.glopid-r.org), PREPARE (www.prepare-europe.eu) and ECRAID (www.ecraid.eu).
